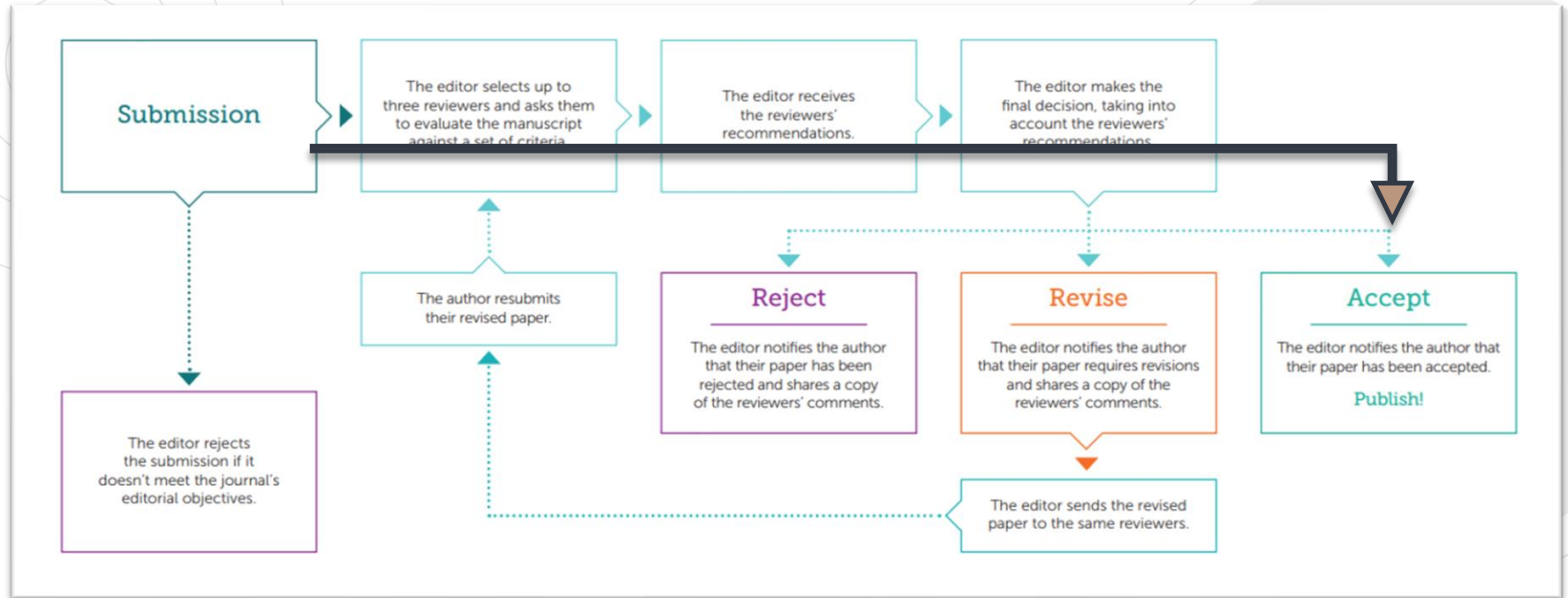

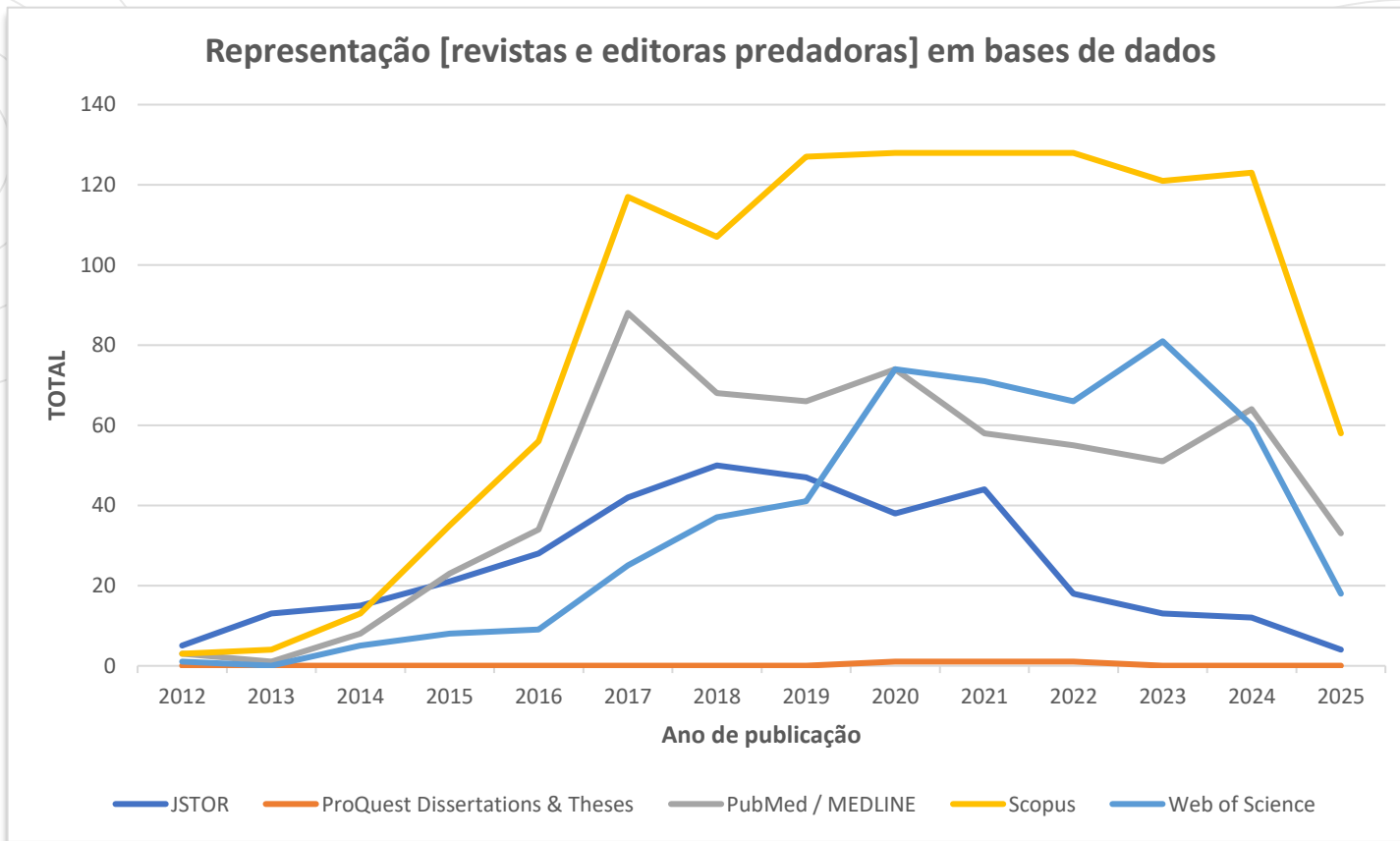

Revistas predadoras – questões editoriais

- Trabalho desenvolvido por uma pessoa e por um computador
- Títulos de revistas similares ou próximos dos das revistas legítimas
- Uso de títulos consolidados e respeitados: Global, International, Universal, Asian, American, European...
- O âmbito da publicação é pouco claro ou é apresentado de forma vaga
- Grande variedade de temas e alcance multidisciplinar para atrair investigadores de todas as disciplinas
- Alta taxa de aprovação de artigos
- De carácter internacional, mas publica poucos artigos de autores conhecidos ou internacionais
- Uso do ISSN para demonstrar que se trata de uma revista de investigação

Revistas predadoras – direitos de autor / APC

- Exige-se dos autores a cessação de direitos, apesar de defenderem o acesso aberto
- Aprovação garantida da publicação, um ciclo de revisão curto e rápido (entre um dia e uma semana), um processo de publicação rápido e fácil, com pouco ou nenhum controlo de qualidade
- Os APC podem estar ocultos
- Algumas revistas negam-se a retirar os artigos a pedido do autor e cobram uma taxa de remoção

Revistas predadoras – Cons. editorial / Peer review

- Conselho editorial reduzido ou por anunciar: os nomes dos que o compõem não correspondem a investigadores conhecidos; membros de diferentes países para dar à revista um aspeto internacional
- O *editor-in-chief* é também o *editor-in-chief* de muitas outras revistas de temática similar ou do mesmo grupo editorial
- Costumam adicionar nomes de investigadores reais, sem o seu consentimento, aos conselhos editoriais para ganhar credibilidade

Revistas predadoras – indexação e preservação

- Indexação de artigos em bases de dados de renome como PubMed, MEDLINE, DOAJ ou Web of Science, imitando o logotipo e aplicando-o no seu *website*
- Declarações falsas e enganosas sobre um fator de impacto alto e falso, como Scientific Journal Impact Factor, Global Impact Factor, Journal Impact Factor, Universal Impact Factor, Science Impact Factor, International Scientific Indexing, Indian Citation Index, African Quality Center for Journals
- Não apresentam informação sobre a preservação digital dos artigos

Revistas predadoras – comunicação e difusão

- Sinais de advertência no *website*
- A forma de contacto é um apartado postal
- Revistas geridas a partir de um *website* altamente sofisticado, com um visual e estética à imagem do das revistas indexadas de renome
- Uso de endereços de *email* do gmail, yahoo ou qualquer outro fornecedor correio eletrónico gratuito
- Campanhas massivas de *spam*, intensas, repetitivas e agressivas
- Envio frequente de convites por *email* para recrutar interessados em proferir palestras ou para integrar conselhos de revisores das revistas
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- Locais de publicação falsos que afirmam estar localizados em Londres quando estão situados no Sul da Ásia ou noutro continente

This came to light in July 2018, when a putative speaker from a university in Florida e-mailed to say that he was having difficulties finding details about an event on pharmaceutical formulations to be held later that month. Exchanges with this speaker and others led me to conclude that this event was in some way not 'real'. I e-mailed the conference organizers to get my name and profile removed from the conference website, but received no reply. My university's legal office said that it was unable to take any action, because the university's logo had not been used.

I subsequently discovered that an article had also been published under my name in a journal associated with the same outfit, apparently, the publication claimed, after I had presented a poster at a US conference in 2015. A 'free of charge' résumé had been created for me, again without my knowledge.

Such activities affect researchers' reputations and potentially our careers. How many researchers in Malaysia and elsewhere have been similarly affected? And who can we seek help from?

Sometimes someone will create a counterfeit website that pretends to be the website of a legitimate scholarly journal. The website creators then solicit manuscript submissions for the hijacked version of the journal, pocketing the money. In some cases, the legitimate versions of the journals are only published in print form and they may not have websites.

In the table below, the hijacker is listed in the left column; the corresponding authentic version of the journal is on the right. In cases where no website can be found for the original journal, a link is made to a bibliographic record for the journal.

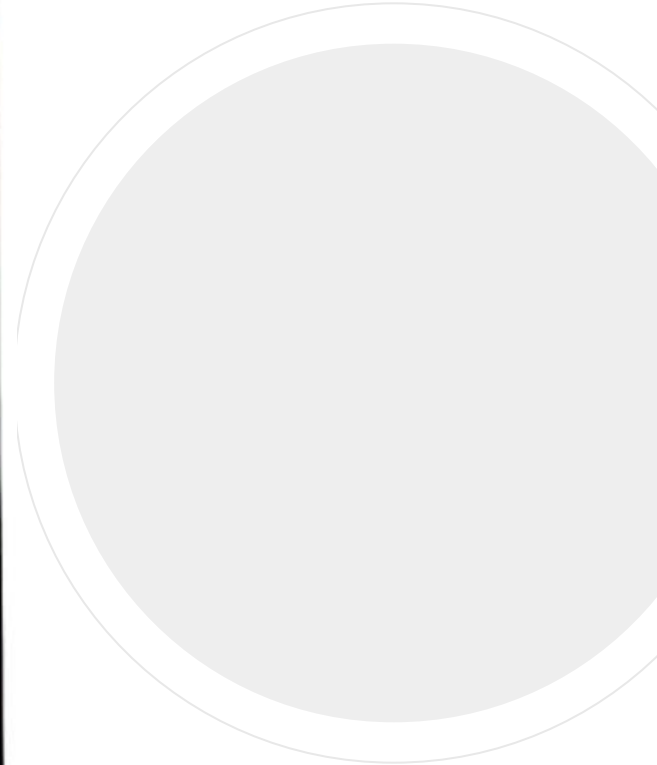

- Título da publicação e possibilidade da sua manipulação artística
- Identificação do *editor-in-chief* e do conselho editorial
- O *editor-in-chief* assegura a mesma função noutras revistas do mesmo grupo editorial?
- Âmbito claro e objetivo da publicação
- Política e prática editorial clara e objetiva
- Taxa de aceitação de artigos (verificar as datas de submissão e aprovação dos artigos já publicados)
- Internacionalidade dos autores

Algumas recomendações aos investigadores (2)

- Oferta de descontos ou isenção de pagamento de APC para investigadores júnior/países de baixos rendimentos
- Identificação de instruções e diretrizes detalhadas para os autores
- Fator de impacto legítimo
- Evidência da preservação digital dos conteúdos publicados
- Análise do *website*: publicidade, erros ortográficos e gramaticais, contactos reais, imagens com pouca definição, construção muito semelhante à de outras revistas, etc.

Algumas recomendações aos investigadores (3)

- Consultar: OPEN ACCESS SCHOLARLY PUBLISHERS ASSOCIATION (OASPA), COMMITTEE ON PUBLICATION ETHICS (COPE) ou o SCIENTIFIC, TECHNICAL AND MEDICAL PUBLISHERS (STM)
- A revista consta do DOAJ?
- A revista consta do ULRICH'S PERIODICALS DIRECTORY?
- Os artigos estão indexados nas principais bases de dados internacionais (MEDLINE/PubMed, Scopus, Web of Science)?

Algumas recomendações aos investigadores (análise do impacto)

- Universal Impact Factor
- Science Impact Factor
- Global Impact Factor
- International Scientific Indexing
- SCIJournal
- Indian Citation Index
- African Quality Center for Journals

Algumas recomendações aos investigadores (congressos e conferências) (1)

- Convites fora da área do investigador
- Convite p/ *keynote* (investigador c/ pouca experiência)
- Revisão por pares fraca ou inexistente
- Convites implicam um pagamento
- Pesquisar *online* os nomes da conferência e do organizador (o que dizem os outros?)
- Verificar a afiliação com uma associação científica estabelecida
- Comparar as taxas de inscrição com as de outras conferências na área

Algumas recomendações aos investigadores (congressos e conferências) (2)

- Analisar minuciosamente quaisquer patrocínios comerciais
- Analisar os materiais de marketing de conferências (turismo em vez de ciência)
- Analisar erros de ortografia e gramática nos materiais da conferência
- Verificar se o local está listado (contactar o local se necessário)
- Desconfiar de contactos como *chatbot*, mensagens ou *email* com aparência não oficial
- Analisar os *proceedings* de conferências anteriores (ler para avaliar a qualidade)
- Cuidado com *emails* de convite para conferências que são sinalizados como spam
- Permanecer cético relativamente a convites lisonjeiros para conferências



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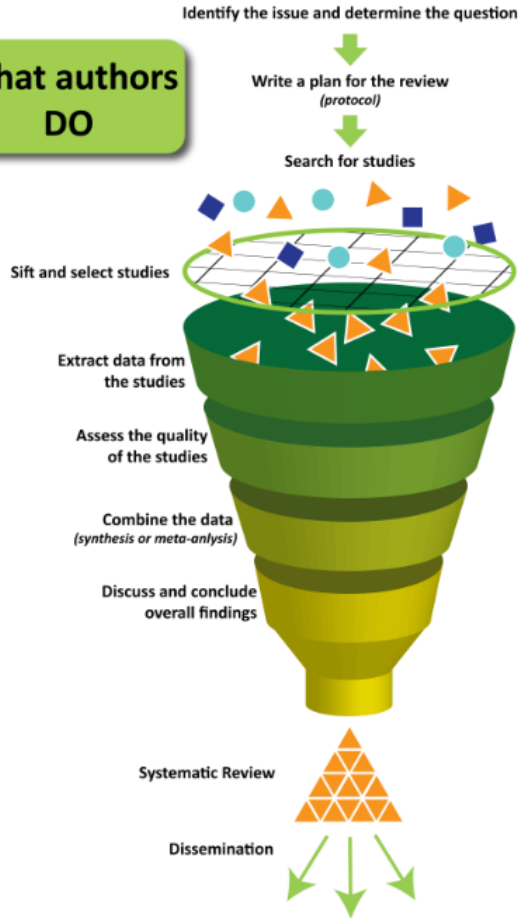

Abstract

The problem of predatory journals and publishers in the health field is analyzed, identifying characteristics and the insights acquired. A review of health literature indexed in ProQuest, PubMed, Scopus, SciELO, and Web of Science was conducted in 2020 and 2021. The data survey was confirmed in March 2022. The analysis allowed the characterization of the phenomenon and verify the negative effects on the health sciences, and therefore a set of recommendations was written for the researchers. 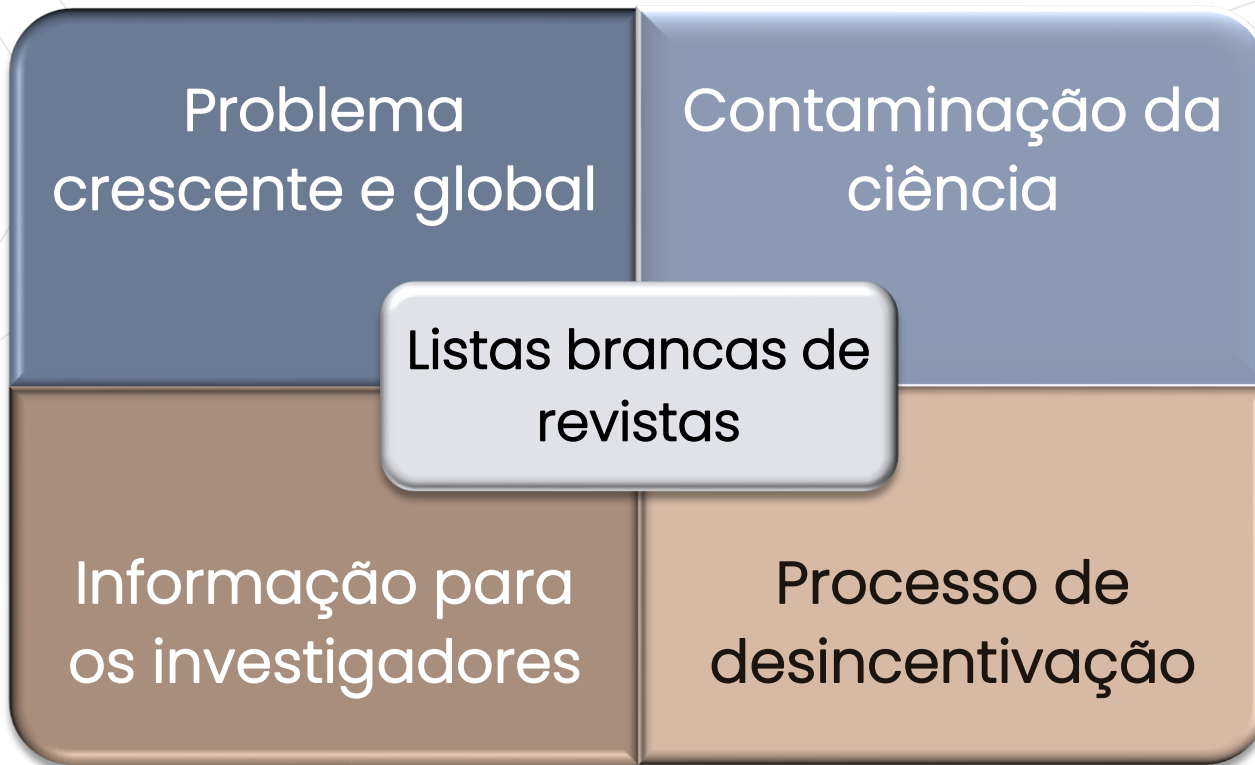
